'Handle with Care' notification

All children come to school with a variety of emotions. At Hunter, we have a 'Handle with Care' alert system. If you feel we need to know about something that has happened at home that may have an impact on your child's learning in school for that particular day, please notify us at the school either by telephone or email. This information is treated with sensitivity and communicated to the class teacher and Support Staff so that we can ensure your child is as settled as possible during school hours.



Adverse Weather - reminder

As we see the weather beginning to change it is important to have a plan in place to ensure the safety and welfare of all children, staff, and members of the public. (A detailed Adverse Weather Plan is posted on the school website and app (information section)).

Patch icy ground, light snow, or rain:

Where there is **patchy icy ground**, **light snow**, **or rain**, school start/finish routines will remain as normal. We advise that children are not brought to school until **just before the 9.00 am bell** and avoid entering playground spaces until then (unless attending Breakfast Club). On days of **heavy rain**, pupils will enter the building before the 9 am bell **(from 8.50 am)** where they will walk directly to their class and will be supervised by class monitors and Support Staff.

Heavy snow/mostly icy playground spaces:

In the instance of deep snow, SLC Head Teachers have the authority to delay school opening until 10 am. We will ensure this is communicated as quickly as possible (via the school app, Twitter, school website).

SLC ask Janitors to guarantee <u>one</u> clear pathway into the school. Clearly for a school like ours, with many access points/gates, this would be challenging. In instances of **heavy snow/mostly icy playground spaces** Davy (janitor) will endeavour to clear as much as he is able to. I ask you to be mindful of this as it is a big job for Davy, and he may not manage all access points/routes into the school.

The school needs to close early:

This situation is also extremely rare and will always be avoided, where possible. Where an early closure is deemed necessary by the Head Teacher in conjunction with SLC HQ. The decision to close early will depend on the assessed safety and welfare of children, current weather conditions in the area, the weather forecast, road and traffic conditions and availability of staff.

Under these circumstances we will use all communication channels available parents/carers should: *Check for updates on the school app - Check the SLC and school websites for updates - Follow SLC and school twitter - Check the Parent Council Facebook page - Listen to local radio stations e.g Radio Clyde.*

Room 3 will then deliver these cards each day. Can you please mark clearly on the envelope the child's name and room number that you are sending the card to.






